The Nonprofit Network strengthens the nonprofit sector across the region by serving as a hub for connection, collaboration, and capacity-building. We provide education, resources, thought leadership, and facilitate collective action around issues that are important to our Members and to the sector. Goal of the Opportunity: The MHC Impact Coordinator will be the lead staff member responsible for implementing the Nonprofit Network's expansion in Martinsville-Henry County. We're looking for someone who loves bringing people together and believes in the power of community. As the MHC Impact Coordinator, you'll be the connector, listener, and guide who helps nonprofits access the tools, relationships, and resources they need to thrive. You'll build trust with local leaders, spark partnerships, and create spaces where organizations can learn from one another.
